In Fall 2011, the Center for Translational Social Neuroscience awarded \$80,000 in Pilot Project Venture Grants. Four pilot projects proposing research in line with the CTSN mission and that were designed to generate preliminary data in support of a larger proposal were funded.

The 2011 Pilot Project grants are \$20,000 per award and are 1 year in duration.
